

## Supply List for 8<sup>th</sup> Crew

### Please bring for the first day of school:

-Lunch or lunch money and a healthy snack

-Refillable water bottle

- 1 Notebook. college ruled, 100 pages, roughly 8 x 10. I will supply one for Language Arts.

\*A book of your choice at your reading level. It can be one you already are reading. You will begin weekly responses with this book on day 1 or 2!

-A backpack or messenger bag or whatever works to get materials to and from home.

-Pencils - mechanical preferred (with refills)- or sharpened #2

-Eraser (white erasers are easiest on paper) or eraser caps, if using "regular" pencils

-Glue stick

-A "communication" folder for notes and homework traveling to and from school. This will be important at the beginning with all of the paperwork that tends to get generated.

\*A small pencil pouch or pocket to remove from backpack and place on or in desk.

Helps keeps your items as YOUR items when we switch classrooms.

- 1 or 2 Ultra fine-tipped black Sharpies for project work

-2 highlighters for text coding

- 3x5 Index cards, white, (plain or ruled)

Much of the work we do in 8<sup>th</sup> is done electronically. The Google system we use in Grass Valley is quite efficient for school and home. We do recommend that students do not rely on phones for completion of assignments. A Chromebook, laptop, or workstation computer is highly recommended. At the very least a tablet with a keyboard. Students can expect a fair amount of writing. The Chromebooks (new) we will issue at school are NOT for home use.

#### Optional (We do have all of these available in the classroom for shared use):

-Colored pencils

-Ruler with a metal edge

-A pair of scissors

-Colored, felt-tip markers

#### Some of the other items that are provided:

- Academic year planner

- Writing response journals
